These schools are run by Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, New Delhi which is an autonomous organization under the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. These schools are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education which consist student from class 6th to 12th standard. They provide a very good environment for the students consist of various components like culture, values, adventure activities, and physical education, etc. Navodaya Vidhyalaya every year offers admission to students of class 6th and 9th. An entrance exam is conducted for the selection of students for admission. The candidates who want to seek Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Admission Form 2021-22 Class 6th & Class 9th can check the details regarding it from this article.

### **Navodaya Vidyalaya Admission 2021 Application Form:**

The candidates who wish to get Navodaya Vidyalaya Admission 2021-22 can fill the Navodaya Form 2021 form. The application form will be made available through an online medium. The candidates can get admission for class 6th and 9th. The interested candidate needs to submit the application form before the last date for submitting the form.

### **Procedure to Apply for JNV Admission 2021:**

- ✓ Visit the official website of Navodaya Vidhyalaya
- ✓ Click on the direct link available to the Navodaya Form 2021.
- ✓ Fill the details of the JNV Admission 2021 Application Form.
- ✓ Upload the documents asked in the application form.
- ✓ Recheck the details and submit.
- ✓ Make the payment.
- ✓ Take out the print out of the application form and keep it for future use.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

In this section candidates can find below the JNV Admission 2021 Eligibility Criteria for the Class 6th and Class 9th:

### **Eligibility For 6th Class Admission:**

- ✓ The candidate must be studying in class 5th.
- ✓ The age of the candidate should be between 9-13 years.
- ✓ Candidates are not allowed to appear for the test for the second time irrespective of the circumstances.

- ✓ The candidate must be studying in class 8th
- ✓ The age of the candidate should be between 13-16 years.
- ✓ The rural quota is considered only when the candidates have studied classes III, IV, and V in a rural area school.

### Reservations:

- (a) At least 75% of the seats in a district are filled by candidates selected from rural areas and remaining seats are filled from urban areas of the district.
- b) Reservation of seats in favour of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is provided in proportion to their population in the district concerned provided that in no district, such reservation will be less than the national average (15% for SC and 7.5% for ST) but subject to maximum of 50% for both the categories (SC & ST) taken together. These reservations are interchangeable and over and above the candidates selected under open merit.
- (c) One third of the total seats are filled up by girls.
- (d) There is a provision for reservation of 3% seats for \*\* Divyang children (i.e. Orthopedically Handicapped, Hearing Impaired and Visually Handicapped).

**\*\* "Blindness" refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions namely:-**

- (i) Total absence of sight; or
- (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses; or
- (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse.

**\*\* "Hearing Impairment" means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.**

**\*\* "Locomotor disability" means disability of the bones joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.**

**\*\* "Person with disability" means a person suffering from not less than forty percent of any disability as certified by a medical authority.**

### Navodaya Form 2021 Fee:

- ✓ There are no fees for the students from class 6th to 8th.
- ✓ From class 9th to 12th there is a fee of INR 1200/- per annum.
- ✓ The wards of government employees need to pay Rs. 1500/-

- ✓ There is no fee for students of SC/ST category

### **Selection and Admission**

- (a) Selection in the test will not vest any right on the candidate to secure admission into the JNV. At the time of seeking actual admission, each selected candidate will have to produce all relevant certificates, as prescribed by the Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti. Until admission, the selection is provisional only. Candidates are advised to apply for TC from parent school only after the verification of documents and confirmation of admission by respective JNV.
- (b) In case of any dispute, the decision of Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti shall be final and binding on the candidates.
- (c) Marks obtained by candidates (both selected and not selected) in the test are not communicated.
- (d) There is no provision for re-evaluation of the answer scripts or re-totalling of marks, since the result is processed through computer and sufficient care is taken to ensure accuracy through various checks in processing the result.
- (e) It may also be noted by the candidates and their parents/guardians that under the scheme of NVS, students of a JNV located in Hindi speaking State may have to be migrated to another JNV in Non-Hindi Speaking State and vice-versa for one academic year when the students are promoted to Class IX. In case of refusal by the students selected for migration, continuation of study of such students in JNV will not be allowed.
- (f) The candidates and their parents/guardians may note that the children selected on the basis of the Test will be admitted only in the JNV located in the district from where they are studying in class V and appearing at the JNVST. Under no circumstances, the selected candidate will be given admission to any other JNV. No request for shifting of students on account of medium of instruction in the JNV concerned, shifting of parents/guardians to other district(s) /State(s) etc. will be entertained.
- (g) Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) will have to produce a certificate of the Caste/Tribe at the time of seeking admission, if selected. Such certificate should be obtained from the competent authority before 15th April of the year of seeking admission so that it may be submitted to the Principal of JNV concerned at the time of verification of document. For example, candidates seeking admission during 2019-20 should get the certificate on or before 15th April 2019.
- (h) Candidates applying for admission under Rural Category will have to produce a certificate to the effect that the school(s) where candidates studied classes III, IV and V is located in Rural Area.

(i) Candidates belonging to the Divyang category (Orthopedically Handicapped, Hearing Impaired and Visually Handicapped) if selected will have to produce a medical certificate signed by Chief Medical Officer of the District concerned at the time of admission in appropriate format.

(j) Candidates belonging to transgender category will have to submit a certificate from the competent authority prescribed by the concerned State Govt. with regard to their gender. No reservation is made for this category.

### **Documents to be submitted after selection**

The parents of the candidates who qualify the Selection Test will have to submit the following documents at the time of admission for verification: -

- (a) Residence Certificate in prescribed perfoma in case of NIOS study only ii) Proof for date of birth.
- (b) Proofs for eligibility as per the conditions of NVS.
- (c) For candidates seeking admission under rural quota, the parents will also have to submit a certificate to the effect that the child had studied in an Institution located in a notified rural area.
- (d) Any other documents required.
