

The Rashtriya Indian Military College is an Inter Services Institute and a Category 'A' establishment of the Ministry of Defence alongside institutions like National Defence Academy, Khadakvasla, Officers' Training Academy, Chennai, and Indian Military Academy, Dehradun. The College provides public school education to young boys in the age group of 11 1/2 to 18 years specially selected through an All India competitive examination. A dedicated feeder to the National Defence Academy and the NAVAC Academy. The College aims to send maximum boys to the NDA/NAVAC. Hence it puts emphasis on complete education and all round personality development of the cadets. However in the event of a boy not joining the NDA due to any reason, the RIMC guarantees, through the five years of academic course, that he attains enough academic proficiency to get admission in any professional or any other college in the Country.

### **Admission procedure**

Approx. 25 cadets are admitted every six months. Candidates should not be less than 11 1/2 years of age or must not have attained the age of 13 on 01 (Jan) or 01 (July) of the term they join. Admissions are made to Class VIII only. The candidate must be studying in Class VII or have passed class VII from a recognized school at the time of joining. Application forms are to be submitted to respective State Governments. Candidates are selected on the basis of their performance in an All India Entrance Examination held twice a year comprising a written examination consisting of question papers in English (125 marks), Mathematics (200 marks) and General Knowledge (75 marks), Successful candidates are called for Viva Voce test (50 marks).

### **Destination**

The College provides education on the lines of residential public schools principally for boys who desire to join the Defence forces of India. Those who do not succeed in this aim or decide against it are well qualified to join a college or professional Institution on graduation from the RIMC. However, the College advises only those to apply who are interested in taking up the challenge of serving the Defence forces of India.

### **Prospectus**

The prospectus cum application form and booklet of old question papers can be obtained from the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Garhi Cantt, Dehradun, Uttarakhand Pin Code 248003 through Speed Post by forwarding self-addressed slip and an account payee Bank Demand Draft of Rs 600/- for general Candidates Rs 555/- for ST/SC candidates along with Caste Certificate. The Demand Draft will be made in favour of **"THE COMMANDANT RIMC DEHRADUN", BRANCH SBI TEL BHAWAN, DEHRADUN BANK CODE 01576, UTTARAKHAND**. The address should be typed /

written clearly in capital letters with pin code and contact number. RIMC will not be responsible for any postal delay and loss in transit of prospectus caused by illegible or incomplete address.

**Note:**

1. The application forms issued by the RIMC only shall be valid. Locally printed/ photocopied and without RIMC hologram (Seal) forms shall not be accepted.
2. No refund of the application fee on any condition

**1. AGE**

Candidates (boys only) appearing for the above test should not be less than  $11\frac{1}{2}$  years in age but should not have attained the age of 13 years as on 01 Jan 2021 i.e. they should have been born not earlier than 02 Jan 2008 and not later than 01 Jul 2009.

**Note:-** *The actual dates notified, from time to time, by the Government of India, in all the National/leading newspapers will be adhered to.*

**2. Educational Qualification**

Candidates should either be studying in Class VII or passed Class VII from any recognized school at the time of admission to the RIMC i.e. on 1 Jan 2021.

**3. Scheme of Examination:**

The examination comprises of

(a) Written Examination: The written part of the examination will consist of three papers, namely, English (1000 - 1200 hrs) and Mathematics (1400 - 1530 hrs) shall be conducted on 01 (sun) Dec 2019 and General Knowledge paper (1000 - 1100 hrs) on 02 Jun 2020 (Tuesday). Minimum pass marks in each paper is 50%.

(b) Viva Voice: The interview date shall be 06 Oct 2020 (Tuesday), and interview will be held for only those candidates who qualify in the written exam, Minimum pass marks in the Interview is 50% and the date and venue for Interview will be intimated to them by respective States by first week of Sep 2020. Intelligence and personality of the candidates will be tested in the interview.

(c) Medical Examination: All the candidates qualified after interview will undergo a medical examination at selected Military Hospitals and only those candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC. The medical examination of the candidates forms only a part of the system of selection and does not imply the final selection.

(d) As per the Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter No. A/36105/GS/MT-6/D(GS-II) dated 03 Sep 2014, the wards of Central Government employees can undertake their written exam

and viva - voice at the place of employee/ domicile state. However, their domicile will be as per original domicile state and accordingly, their candidature will also be considered as per the state of domicile. Therefore, it is mandatory to get the application deposited in the state where the exam has to be undertaken.

(e) The interviews will be held for only those candidates who pass the written exam. The list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval of MT Directorate.

(f) It is mandatory for all the selected candidates (including candidates from all India Reserve Merit List, if selected) to join RIMC with 10 days of commencement of term as per the joining instructions. If the selected candidate fails to join within 10 days, his candidature will be cancelled and next reserve candidate will be called to join.

(g) Vacancies for Jan 2021 Term, in all respect will be filled by 30 Jan 2021. No Candidate will be allowed to join RIMC after 30 Jan 2021 under any circumstances (incl medical).

(h) Results and joining instructions will be regularly updated on RIMC website. It is candidate's responsibility to check the status regularly.

#### **4. Examination Centres:**

Examination centres are generally located in the state capitals or in cities/towns as advertised.

#### **5. Fee:**

Fees at RIMC is heavily subsidized by the Central Govt. The fee is presently Rs.42,400/- per year. It may increase from time to time. At the time of entry a Security Deposit of Rs.20,000/- is to be made. This is refunded when the boy passes out.

#### **6. Scholarships:**

Scholarships are granted by various state Govts to meritorious students. The amount of scholarships varies from state to state and is in between Rs.10,000/- to Rs.40,000/- per annum. Continuation of Scholarship once granted by the state is subject to merit, income and discipline of the cadet and his performance during the year.

#### **7. Procedure to Obtain Application Forms:**

The prospectus - cum - application form and booklet of old question papers can be obtained from the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Garhi Cantt, Dehradun, Uttarakhand, Pin - 248003 through:-

##### **(a) Online Payment:**

The prospectus - cum - application form and booklet of old question papers can also be obtained by making online payment of Rs.600/- for General Candidates & Rs.555/- for SC/ST candidates on

RIMC website [www.rimc.gov.in](http://www.rimc.gov.in). On receipt of the payment the prospectus – cum application form and booklet of old question papers will be dispatched by Speed post only.

or

### (b) By Sending Demand Draft:

The prospectus – cum – application form and booklet of old question papers can be obtained by sending a written request with a demand draft of Rs.600/- for General Candidates & Rs.555/- for SCt/ST candidates along with caste certificate in favour of **“THE COMMANDANT RIMC DEHRADUN”, DRAWEE BRANCH, STATE BANK OF INDIA, TEL BHAVAN, DEHRADUN, (BANK CODE - 01576), UTTARAKHAND**. The address should be TYPED/ WRITTEN clearly in CAPITAL LETTERS with pin code and contact number. RIMC will NOT be responsible for any postal delay or loss in transit of prospectus caused by illegible or incomplete address. The delay on part of postal department is not the responsibility of this institution.

### 8. Last Date:

Application in duplicate on prescribed form accompanied by documents to be attached with application form (Two passport size photographs, Domicile Certificate of the candidate, Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/Gram Panchayat, SC, ST Certificate from principal of the School in original with photograph on it attested stating date of birth and in which Class studying). Application forms should reach the respective State Governments (as specified in the press note) of which their parents / guardians are domicile of, 31<sup>st</sup> March 202. Kindly note the application forms must be send to the State Govts and not to be Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun, Uttarakhand.
