All the remaining vacant seats in other classes (VI to IX & XI) will be filled under Outstanding Sportsperson Category (OSP)/Lateral Entry on the basis of criteria mentioned by institution in prospectus. OSP category applicant will only undergo sports specific test and there was not be any PESAT and Written test. Tournaments should have been held between academic year 2022-23 & 2023-24 only will be considered.

I. Super Category: Direct Admission without Sports Trial

Sportspersons who have represented India in the under-mentioned Competition(s), recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Direct Admission without Sports Trial.

- 3. Applicants are required to upload Self-Attested copies of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate. However, only the Highest Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for Marking.
